### Questions posed during walkthrough:

Does Medina County currently have a vendor? No

If an inmate has a medical emergency who do you currently take the inmate to? Medina Regional Hospital

There is a body scanner in the intake area does it work? Yes

And if so what does it scan? Large objects

Can it scan body cavities as well? Yes

If someone is combative or under the influence do you have a team to secure them? Yes

The area on the outside, is it secure? Yes

With the addition how many beds will you have? 192

Are there any pressure cells? Yes 2

The segregation hall has mental health cells? Yes

Who do you get meds from? Diamond Pharmacy

Do you use an EMR? (Electronic Medical Records)? No

So they are all paper? Yes

What is the timeline from intake to booking? It depends on how busy the Jail is. Usually it is 30minutes to 2 hours.

What is the average intakes in a 24 hour period? 6-10 per day

Do the inmates receive care during the week? A local doctor comes in every Tuesday whether or not he is needed or not. That Dr is contracted by Medina Regional Hospital.

How long is his visit? It can range from 15 min to an hour

Is there any nursing staff? No

How often is pill pass? 4xs a day

How many people are on meds? 20-25 people

Who dispenses the meds? The medical officer during the day and in the evenings it is the Sgt. on duty.

What is your current staff? We are 5 down but he are in the middle of hiring 3.

What is your full staff? 32

What is your standard cell size? We have 2 cells that house 18 and the rest house 8.

How many violent cells do you have? 2

What is the daily average? 90 this morning however, we have 30 to 40 housed out of county.

Once open completely do you plan to bring those other inmates back? Yes

So you anticipate approximately 120 inmates when we start? Yes

Do you keep medications here? No we just keep a 30 day supply on hand and we order from the pharmacy.

What pharmacy do you use? Diamond Drugs

Do you have a backup pharmacy? Yes we use the local Walmart pharmacy.

Is there a company that you use for mental health? Yes, we use Faspsych for a mental health assessment and we also use MHDD for crisis.

Are you open to an electronic medical records system? We are trying to go paperless, please add any additional suggestions and costs to the proposal submitted.

What is the Jail Management Solution? Enterprise Justice (FKA Odyssey) by Tyler Technologies

Are you looking for a nurse 24/7? That is up to what you suggest we need according to what we have provided.

2. What is the average daily population (ADP) for 2024 so far? The RFP states that Medina County Jail is a 192 bed facility, however on the Cost Proposal page it states 196, is this what the ADP for pricing should be based on?

Average Daily Population – January 1, 2024 – February 26, 2024 – 83. However, once the jail is completely open, it may be 150. However, we would like to plan for max capacity which would be 192.

3. The RFP mentions providing an Electronic Medical Record (EMR), does the county currently have an EMR in place? No we do not.
4. In the RFP the term of contract states that the contract will commence on March 18<sup>th</sup>. The RFP also states that commissioners will take action on this item on March 18<sup>th</sup>. Will there be a minimum of 30-45 days for contract start up to include recruiting, setting up service agreements, and much more? Yes, vendor can have a 30 day deployment and planning period commencing approximately in mid April.
