Burn Procedures

1.	Red	Flag	Warnings	- *	DO	NOT	BURN *

2. ALWAYS ... check weather for wind advisories!

* DO NOT BURN IF WINDS ARE MORE THAN 10 MPH *

Contact Sheriff's Office and give them the Location of the Burn and when you will start to burn.

The Sheriff's Office must be contacted again once you are done and the fire is completely extinguished. 830-741-6153

- 3. Burn **cannot** be left unattended at any time!
- 4. Have a water source available.
- 5. Have a source of communication in case Emergency Services are needed.
- All burn piles must be kept at a reasonable size, so that they may be extinguished quickly if necessary.
- 7. No burning after dark and all fires must be extinguished by nightfall.
